- **Climate change knows no borders.**

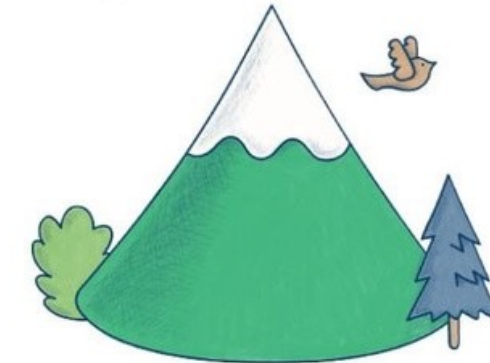
